

Logging into assembly using Google Classroom

Desktop/laptop

To join the assembly, click onto the 9 dots in the top right hand corner of the webpage and select calendar, you should have a blue strip in your calendar at 10am. Click on this and select the 'Join with Google Meet' and you're in! (There's a video attached too so that you can see what I mean.) (nb. you have two calendars - a Y6 one and a personal one, the personal one is in the 9 dots and allows you access to the assembly).

Tablet/phone

Download Google Meet app.

Sign in with your username e.g. n.drake@stcharlesprimary.co.uk (you must replace the @stcharlesrc with @stcharlesprimary.co.uk) it will then ask you to sign into RMUnify - put your usual login details in and it will send you back to Google Meet and the invite for assembly will be there!

When accessing the teachers meetings, click on the link in Google Classroom in your stream or the camera at the top of the classwork page. This will then redirect you to the app that you downloaded earlier.

Safety

Remember to tell people in your house that you have your webcam on and check what's in your background, especially when you have your camera on and turn off your microphone unless you are speaking.
